

BYLAW #1195/08

TOWN OF NANTON

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NANTON, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO BYLAW #1105/01 BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF ANY BUSINESS OPERATING WITHIN THE TOWN OF NANTON

1. ENACTMENT:

- 1.1. WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and equitable to enact a Bylaw to provide for the licensing of any business operating within the Town of Nanton; and
- 1.2. WHEREAS it is provided in and by the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, that the Council may regulate and license any type of business or industry; and
- 1.3. WHEREAS Council passed Resolution 426 – 07/12/13 at its December 13, 2007, Special Meeting authorizing the amendment of Business License Bylaw #1105/01; and
- 1.4. WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended from time to time, authorizes such amendments;
- 1.5. NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Nanton in the Province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

2. AMENDMENT:

- 2.1 THAT Bylaw No. 1105/01 is amended as follows:

3. EFFECTIVE DATES AND READINGS:

- 3.1 Town of Nanton Bylaw #1122/02, an amendment to Business License Bylaw #1105/01, is hereby repealed.
- 3.1 This bylaw becomes effective February 16, 2008.
