

**TOWN OF NANTON**

**BYLAW NO. 1207/09**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NANTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND WATER-  
WORKS, SEWERS AND PLUMBING BYLAW #1164/05.**

**1. ENACTMENT:**

- 1.1 WHEREAS Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, authorizes a Council to pass bylaws;
- 1.2 NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Nanton, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:
- 1.3 This bylaw hereby amends the Water-Works, Sewers and Plumbing Bylaw #1164/05, by revising Schedule "A" as reflected in this Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming a part of this Bylaw, and Schedule "B" of Bylaw #1164/05, as reflected in this Schedule "B", attached hereto and forming a part of this Bylaw.

**2. INTERPRETATION:**

- 2.1 This Bylaw will be cited as the Amendment to Water-Works, Sewers and Plumbing Bylaw #1164/05.

**3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND READINGS:**

- 3.1 Bylaw No. 1164/05 is hereby amended, and Bylaw No. 1171/06 is hereby repealed.
- 3.2 This Bylaw will come into force and effect on July 1, 2009.
- 3.3 READ a first time this 4<sup>th</sup> day of May, A.D., 2009.
