BYLAW NO. 1146/04

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NANTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BUSINESS LICENSE BYLAW #1105/01.

1. ENACTMENT:

- 1.1 WHEREAS Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, authorizes a Council to pass bylaws;
- 1.2 NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Nanton, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:
 - 1.2.1 This bylaw hereby amends the Business License Bylaw #1105/01, by revising Item 3.3 of the bylaw to read, "Every person applying to operate a business within a Public Land Use District, under direct control of the Town, must receive prior written approval of Council. A business applying to operate within a Public Land Use District, which is not under direct control of the Town, does not require written approval from Council, however, must provide the Town with written approval from the organization operating such property."

2. INTERPRETATION:

- 2.1 This Bylaw will be cited as the Amendment to Business License Bylaw #1105/01.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND READINGS:

- 3.1 Bylaw No. 1105/01 is hereby amended.
- 3.2 This Bylaw amendment will come into force and effect upon third and final reading thereof.
- 3.3 READ a first time this 2nd day of February, A.D., 2004.
- 3.4 READ a second time this 2nd day of February, A.D., 2004.
- 3.5 Upon unanimous consent of those present, read a third and final time this 2nd day of February, A.D., 2004.
